FROM CARMARTHEN

On reaching Kilgetty, take the 2nd exit on the roundabout sign posted Pembroke Dock.

Follow the A477 until you reach the first roundabout, and take the 1st exit signposted Tenby B4318.

> Heatherton is located two miles down on the B4318 on your left.

The Bus Car park is 200 yards past Heatherton and signposted on the right hand-side.

FROM TENBY

Take the B4318 signposted Pembroke Dock. Follow to road for two miles and the Bus Car Park is signposted on the left hand-side.

NOTICES FOR TEACHERS

ON ARRIVAL

one teacher should go to the reception to collect passes. To find the reception, go via the underpass from the overflow car park and follow signs to main reception.

ACTIVITY GUIDANCE

ADVENTURE GOLF All students must have teacher supervision, as it is a Heatherton policy, to eliminate any accidents or bad behaviour.

BUMPER BOATS, MASTER BLASTER, WATER PEDDLERZ & WALK ON WATER Students can get wet due to the nature of the activities, so it is advisable for students to bring a change of clothes if participating on the activities.
